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


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Lelystad has a story to tell



Using sand, clay and silt dredged from the Markermeer lake, new land and shallows are created and become a rich habitat for fish and birds. It contributes to the recovery of the original nature at the Markermeer. Nature lovers will find a wonderful and exciting place to explore.

Natuurpark Lelystad

Nature Park Lelystad is an important link for many endangered animal species on the way to a life in the wild. For example, the Nature Park is the habitat of the bison, wild boar, red deer, Przewalski horse or even the moose. Storks, otters, beavers, mouflons and Father David's deer also live in the park. The animals live in large habitats so it is always a challenge to spot the animals. There is an extensive system of kilometers of walking and cycling paths with picnic areas at various places.

The park has a restaurant with a fantastic view over the central lake and there is a visitor center where you can buy a map, rent a bicycle or obtain information. Groups can explore the park by boat or excursion vehicle led by a guide.



Exposure (2010) - Lelystad - Antony Gormlev

This astonishing 26-meter high steel giant looks out over the Markermeer. At the border of land and water he keeps an eye on the surroundings. You can recognize this squatting human figure from far away.

As you get closer, the figure becomes more and more abstract. All the steel and the height leave you speechless. Intimidating, intriguing and inspiring. You can find him sitting at the dam at the beginning of the Houtribdijk in Lelystad.


Observatorium - Lelystad - Robbert Morris

Seen from above, the circular shapes near the Swifterringweg in Lelystad look exotic among the straight lines of fields, roads and railways. The circles are the concentric earthen ramparts that make up Robert Morris's Observatorium.

Morris made three openings in the earthen ramparts, triangular 'vizors' that make the seasons more visible. Looking through the middle vizor, which is made of steel, you can see the see the sun rise on the days in the autumn and spring when night and day are equally long; 21 September and 21 March. On either side are vizors of Bavarian granite; the left one captures the first rays of sunlight in the summer on the longest day (21 June), the right one captures them in the winter on the shortest day (21 December).

Morris compared the Observatory to Stonehenge, the prehistoric monument that, according to him, also conveys time.

Deltawerk// (2018) -Marknesse - RAAAF | Atelier de Lyon

The Waterloopbos in Marknesse is scattered with scale models of marine infrastructure: this is where the Dutch Waterloopkundig Laboratorium used to test the Delta Works, among other things. The largest water project here was wavemaker Deltagoot, an elongated, concrete channel for experiments involving tsunamiforce waves. Today, all of the test models have fallen into disuse and the laboratory has been closed. The Waterloopbos is now a national monument and the Deltagoot has been transformed into the work of art Deltawerk// by RAAAF | Atelier de Lyon.

The Delta Works symbolise the struggle against water by the inhabitants of the Netherlands. Having been transformed into Deltawerk//, the Deltagoot is now a monument to that struggle and to Dutch ingeniousness in matters of water management. It also raises questions about the pursuit of an indestructible Netherlands at a time of climate change and rising sea levels.

Swifterkamp – back to the past

At a beautiful location in Nature Park Lelystad is a small village called Swifterkamp. The village, which currently has two farms, a huntergatherer hut and three outbuildings, exudes the atmosphere of a bygone era. Occasionally it is inhabited by groups of adults and children who like to experience for a short or longer time what it would be like to live in the New Stone Age; the time when huntergatherers gradually switched to farming life (in the Central Netherlands from about 6300 years ago).


Erfgoedpark Batavialand



E-scooters An awesome opportunity: exploring

Renters must be in possession of a valid moped certificate or driver's license and be at least 18 years old

This kart center in Lelystad offers a challenging and technical track that is 735 meters long, seven meters wide and has many challenging curves. The track is ideal for learning karting or for renting a kart. Thanks to the many curves there are plenty of overtaking opportunities. Safety first: there are various escape lanes and the special formula tires are placed next to the track to absorb any impact. Kartcentrum Lelystad has the fastest rental karts in the Netherlands: racing at 85 km/h or even 120 km/h!

Architecture

Flevoland is man-made land. At the beginning of the reclamation, it provided room for unusual ideas. Enough space to use, resulting in exceptional architecture and design.

Zilverparkkade

One of the many architectural highlights is the Zilverparkkade. A location for both offices and appartments, that consists of a number of modern buildings, developed by various architects. This lane was developed from the idea of breaking through the modernist ideas from which Lelystad originated. It worked out well.

Agoratheater


This orange theater is the eye-catcher of Lelystad. This special building is located in the center and was designed by the renowned architect Ben van Berkel. For the design he took inspiration from the changing skies above Lelystad. This is reflected in the use of color on the inside and outside of the theatre. That is not the only special thing about this building, it is also full of contrasts: the outside and the main hall are diamond-shaped, while the foyer is graceful and round.

Provinciehuis

The Province House is a building designed by architect G. Vermeer. It was already in use in 1980, six years before Flevoland became a province. Like the province, this building has also been modified and expanded over the years. The different parts of the building represent different periods and are connected by a new facade that symbolizes the vastness of the polder landscape.


Street Art in Lelystad

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
